## Student Show Regulations

### **WORK DUE:**

Monday May 12<sup>th</sup> thru Friday May 16<sup>th</sup> between 10am and 3pm. You may submit a total of 3 pieces to the juried exhibition.

### **FRAMING:**

STRICT FRAMING REGULATIONS MUST BE OBSERVED. SEE ENCLOSED SHEET FOR REGULATIONS.

### **LABELS:**

The enclosed labels must be filled out COMPLETELY AND LEGIBLY. You may copy these labels or pick up more at the Academy. You will need to fill out two labels for each submission. PLEASE FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS FOR ATTACHING THE LABELS TO YOUR WORK.

### **EXHIBIT DATES:**

May 30th thru July 26th, 2008. Opening Reception Friday May 30th, 6-8 p.m.

### **Pick up Dates:**

Work from the exhibition may be picked up from July 28 thru August 1<sup>st</sup> between 9am and 4pm. Work not in the show can be picked up to sell the day of the fair. NOAFA is not responsible for work left after December 2008.

### **SALES:**

The Academy Gallery will take 15% of all sales from the Student Show. Remember to consider framing costs and the gallery percentage when figuring the price of your artwork. Also, artwork not for sale should be marked NFS. If you do not put a price on your submission, it will be marked NFS. Students will be paid in the fall for artwork that has sold.

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

Students from the following sessions are eligible: Summer 2007, Fall 2007 and Spring 2008. Because the Student Show is juried, there is no guarantee that every student will have a piece in the show. However, every student may submit a total of three pieces only from any classes taken during the above listed semesters. Notices of acceptance are not sent due to office restrictions.

Color and Design projects are eligible for submission for the juried show. Color and Design Projects that are not submitted to be juried may be matted and labeled and might be displayed in the Color and Design room. These works are not juried and are not part of the exhibition.

Work submitted must be from the class or classes taken. For example:

- If you took only Color and Design, an oil painting is not eligible.
- If you took only Photography, a drawing of your child is not eligible.
- If you took only Figure Sculpture, a ceramic cow is not eligible.
- STUDIOS AND WEEKEND WORKSHOPS ARE NOT CONSIDERED CLASSES.

# Annual Art Fair

**Eligibility:**

All students from the following sessions:

Summer 2007

Fall 2007

Spring 2008

**Date and Time:**

Saturday, May 31st from 9:00 am until 3:00 pm.

Please Note: All participants must arrive by 8:30am and stay until 3:00 pm.

**Location:**

Inside the Academy Annex and in the parking area adjacent to the Annex under a large tent.

**Eligible Works:**

Any work completed during the above listed sessions and/or work relating to classes taught at the Academy. No jewelry, woodcarvings or any other works not pertaining to classes taught at the Academy may be displayed or sold.

**Space Selection:**

This year, ALL SPACES MUST BE RESERVED ...in the Annex AND UNDER THE TENT. You may choose a space when you sign up for the Art Fair in the office. Sign up begins Monday May 12th.

**Cost:**

\$25 per student. Pay in the Academy office.

The Academy will provide tables and chairs. You will need to bring all other supplies for displaying your work. Students are encouraged to come early to set up. Artwork may be framed or unframed. Students price and sell their work with profits for the student only. Students are encouraged to work together in shifts so that someone will be with the displays at all times. Friends and family are welcome to help you. You may bring and display as many pieces as you wish.

**REMEMBER:**

- Work must not be left alone and you must stay until 3pm.
- Also, work not accepted for the show may be picked up the morning of the fair to sell at the fair.

## FRAMING REGULATIONS

Strict framing regulations are to be observed for the work submitted for the Student Show. The reasons for this are manifold, but primarily the Academy wishes to maintain a clean and tasteful appearance to the exhibition. Therefore, it is important that you observe the following regulations:

1. Watercolors, drawings, pastels, graphics and photographs are to be covered with glass (but not glass and clips), plexiglass or shrink-wrap. Use white, off-white or gray mats ONLY. Please no double or triple matting. ONLY WORKS WITH A SINGLE MAT WILL BE ACCEPTED. Framing for the above may be metal or wood frames. GOLD, SILVER OR COLORED FRAMES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

2. On oil and acrylic paintings, use STRIPPING, SMALL METAL FRAMES OR TAPE. NO GOLD, SILVER OR COLORED STRIPPING, FRAMES OR TAPE.

- Colored frames, ornate frames, colored mats, glass and clip framing are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- Please keep your frames small and simple. The width of your molding may not exceed 1 inch.
- Please try to restrict your mat widths in respect of the space limitations at the student show.
- All work must be wired with screw eyes and picture wire and be ready for hanging. Pieces that are matted and shrink-wrapped do not apply to this rule. **No saw tooth hangers!**
- If the work is already framed, but not according to Academy regulations, it must be appropriately re-framed before you submit it for the Student Show.

3. PRINT CLEARLY. The information you put on the labels will be used to type stickers for the wall...therefore the information must be COMPLETE AND LEGIBLE.
4. All work must be priced or we will put NFS (Not For Sale) on the label. Absolutely no works marked POR (Price On Request) will be accepted.
5. KEEP YOUR TITLES VERY SHORT. **33 characters maximum including spaces**
